SCHOLARSHIP

Checklist

- ✓ Apply for admission to a university or college of choice by their respective deadline.
- ✓ Complete this application form. Application must be typed or written in pen. Application and attached materials must be legible. Incomplete applications will be deemed ineligible.
- ✓ Attach a copy of your high school transcript.
- ✓ Attach a copy of your admission acceptance letter.
- ✓ Attach a copy of your ACT Assessment High School Report. A copy of your SAT profile may be included if available.
- ✓ In a carefully composed essay of approximately 500 words, describe how you expect your educational experience in college to affect you as a person.
- ✓ Include a small recent photograph of yourself, if available, for publicity purposes only. Please do not staple the photograph to the application.
- ✓ Return the completed form and the additional materials to: Trimble County Extension Office, P.O. Box 244, 43 High Country Lane, Bedford KY 40006.
- ✓ The application must be postmarked by April 1, 2019. Applications received after the deadline will not be eligible for consideration.
- ✓ Include two (2) letters of recommendation with the application (only one letter may be school related: teacher, principal, guidance counselor, etc.).

APPLICATION DEADLINE: April 1, 2019.

First - Year Students

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of the student's high school grade point average, ACT or SAT scores, writing ability, leadership potential and financial need. This application gives a good overview of each applicant's development in these areas.

- Any Trimble County resident or high school student may apply.
- Applicant must be seeking a Bachelor's degree at a college or university of their choice. Priority will be given to applicants majoring in agricultural sciences, or past involvement in 4-H and/or FFA, but all majors will be considered for the Log House Farm Scholarship.
- Carefully and completely fill out the application form. **Follow the instructions.**
- Applications must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2019.
- Each application will be reviewed by the Log House Farm Scholarship Committee. The committee will decide if a scholarship will be awarded and if so, the amount of the award. Recipients will be notified of the award offer in May.
- A total of \$10,000 in scholarship monies is available to be awarded to either first year students and/or continuing education applicants. The money will be dispersed among the recipients selected.
- Log House Farm Scholarships are awarded for one academic year, in two equal amounts for the fall and spring semesters. A student must maintain a full time student status for the award to be issued.
- Students may re-apply for upperclass scholarships in the spring of each year throughout the course of their undergraduate education and as long as they maintain grades in good standing.
- Scholarships will not exceed actual expenses and will be considered as supplemental to other scholarships or grants already received.
- In the event of the student withdrawing from school, any reimbursed Log House Farm Scholarship monies must be refunded to the Trimble County 4-H Council.
