Tuttle Tots, Inc. was founded in 2012. Caroline, age 3, was killed in a school bus accident October 29, 2012. She was on her way home from the Carroll County Early Childhood Development Center where she was a student. She was affectionately known as "Tuttle Tot" by some of her teachers, thus the name of our organization. Caroline loved her time at school, her teachers, and staff there.
